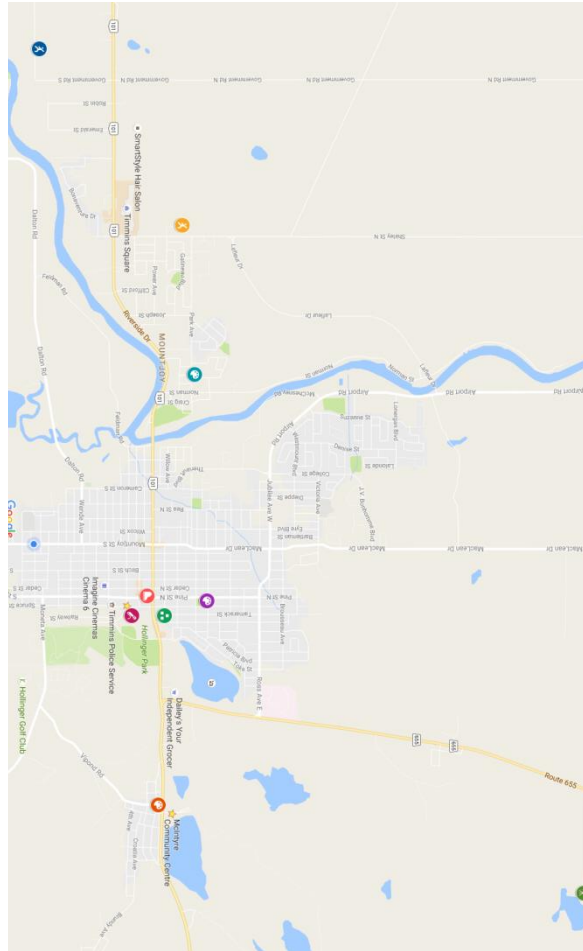
Free Scottish Highland Dance Lesson!
